Le Magor, 29530, Collorec can be found on Google Maps and on most Sat Navs.

gps-coordinates: 48°18'47.9"N 3°47'38.5"W

Gîte Terra is located in the hamlet of Le Magor which is about 4KM to the north of Collorec village.

Below are the directions to Le Magor coming from **Collorec** or from the landmark **La Chappelle de Saint Herbot** which is about 3km from Le Magor.

From Collorec village

From the centre of the village, drive in a northerly direction. The church and the Marie should be on your **right** hand side. Drive straight on and exit the village. Approximately 500 metres from the church you will reach a Y-junction where you will need to keep **left**.


Continue straight ahead – the park should be on your right side - and follow the road which will take you up-hill.

After about 2,5km you will pass a cottage (Ty Coquil) at another Y-junction. Keep **left** here, driving further up the hill. When you reach the brow of the hill, keep going and keep left.

Continue down the hill until you reach another Y-junction at the point where the main road bends sharply left. The turn off you need looks like a continuation of the road you are on, but it is a turn-off.

Le Magor is sign-posted here.

Drive straight ahead into the hamlet. Keep following the tarmac road into the courtyard and someone will meet you there.



From La Chapelle de Saint Herbot (Saint Herbot)

The hamlet of Saint Herbot is located just off the D14, on the road between Huelgoat and Loqueffret. Turn into the hamlet of Saint Herbot and follow the road. The Chapel should be on your right.


Continue up the hill and after about 300 metres, take the first road left (signposted 'Collorec').

Stay on this road for about 2,5km. It's quite curvy with various turn-offs to hamlets.

After about 2,5km, you will see Kerifin on your left. It's a farm house with various buildings directly on the road.

Take the **left** hand turn at Kerifin. Follow the road for another 500 metres. At the point where the road bends sharp right, you will see a **left** hand turn off. This is the Le Magor turn off and it's signposted.

Keep following the tarmac road into a courtyard where someone will meet you.



Please note that, unlike what some navigation systems and Google maps might indicate, there is NO direct road between the hamlet Keraliou (La Pizz'Askya) and Le Magor. You will need to continue on the main road, turn left at Kerifin and then take the first left again into Le Magor.
